#### IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa tries to flip the script after back-to-back losses and snag a win before heading home from Aberdeen.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES:**

North Iowa trails, 1-2-0 (total scoring margin: 13-11).

#### LAST TIME OUT:

The Bulls opened Friday night's game against Aberdeen with an early momentum-builder, but Aberdeen roared back with a major momentum swing of its own in the first period, and added a pair of goals in the final instants of the second period to roll to a 5-2 win over North Iowa in its first-ever home game against the Bulls. A point blast from Sean Vlasich at the 3:36 mark of the first period caught Max Scott in front of the net and bounced past goaltender Dominik Wasik for the opening goal of the day, but the Wings responded with a late-developing 2-on-1 and a goal from Jackson Yee just 45 seconds later. Two more goals from Parks Wallace and Patrick O'Connell just 62 seconds apart gave Aberdeen a 3-1 lead. The Bulls trimmed the lead to a goal with 2:42 remaining in the first, with Ryan Coughlin racing in down the right wing and Scott finishing the play with a stick-side tally. After keeping the game within a goal for most of the second period, the Bulls surrendered two goals - one to Landry Schmuck on a scramble in front of the net, and the other to Jacob Bosse on the next trip down the ice - in the final 30 seconds to send the game to the locker rooms with the Wings up 5-2. North Iowa never scored again despite a 16-7 shots-on-goal advantage in the final 20 minutes and a trio of power play chances. Wasik made 36 saves for his second win of the year, while Hunter Garvey took the loss with 27 stops.

#### **NEXT HOME GAME:**

North Iowa welcomes the Bismarck Bobcats to Mason City for the first time since the spring of 2010 when the Bulls return home on Fleet Farm "Bucks and Pucks" Night Friday, November 5.

#### SHOOTIN' THE BULL:

Both of North lowa's losses to Aberdeen have come despite a shots-on-goal advantage for the Bulls, with a 35-26 advantage in their September 24 meeting. The Bulls are just 3-3 with the advantage on shots, but have posted an outstanding 4-1-0-1 mark despite being outshot in those six games.

### THE END:

Bulls forward Chris Carroll went without a point in Friday's game, ending his point streak at 10 games. The last North Iowa player with a double-digit point streak was Matt Dahlseide, whose 16-game run wrapped up December 29, 2018 in a 3-1 win at the Rochester Grizzlies.

#### TO THE MAX:

After a slow start to his season, forward Max Scott has picked up the offensive production in a big way, posting six points over his last five games after going without a goal in his first eight appearances. His four goals in that stretch matches his total from all of last season, when he made 43 appearances for the Amarillo Bulls, and his five points so far against the Wings tops the team.

### **HELP ME OUT:**

North Iowa forward Ryan Coughlin snapped a long scoring drought in last night's game, earning the assist on Scott's second goal for his first point in six games. The Charlotte, North Carolina native picked up three assists in North Iowa's first two games against Aberdeen last month, and his four assists over the first three meetings remains the team's top mark. Cade Nielson's four assists for the Wings against North Iowa also leads the Aberdeen effort, with Jackson Yee's four goals leading the way against the Bulls in that category.

## TAKING FLIGHT AGAIN?:

Much like the mythological Greek character, Aberdeen's wings hadn't quite gotten them off the ground recently, dropping four of their next five since opening Central Division play with a 3-2 win at North Iowa on September 24. The Wings' off weekend last week likely recharged the batteries a bit -Aberdeen split their most recent weekend with the sixth-place Bismarck Bobcats, charging to a 4-1 win on Friday, October 8 before stumbling to a 3-2 loss the following night. Three of those four losses came in one-goal games, and Aberdeen held the lead at some point in all four defeats.
