

#### IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa makes its final trip to the Odde Ice Center this season, barring a meeting with the Wings in the Robertson Cup Playoffs.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES:**

North lowa trails, 2-3-3 (all three OT losses in shootout; earned 1st-ever road win at Aberdeen January 28).

#### LAST TIME OUT:

The Bulls evened up their head-to-head series with the Austin Bruins last Saturday night, earning a 4-2 win over the Bruins on their annual "Paint the Rink Pink" Night in front of a packed crowd at the Riverside Arena. Austin earned the early go-ahead goal when Anthony Menghini banged in a pointblank one-timer just 2:50 into the contest, but the Bulls got it back at 15:38 when Brett Morich stuffed the puck in the net after a drive down the left wing from Byron Hartley. Hunter Bulger sniped one into the upper half just six seconds later to whip the Bulls into a 2-1 lead. After starting the season with 32 straight unsuccessful power plays against the Bruins, Jake LaRusso tossed the puck into the Bruins' net with just 18 seconds left in the period, sending North Iowa to the intermission with a 3-1 lead. Justin Mexico rattled home a chance to make it 4-1 with 5:03 left in the second period, but Walter Zacher picked up a five-hole marker on the power play with 3:30 left in the period to close out the scoring. LaRusso finished the night with a goal and two assists, and Kyle Kozma wrapped up the evening with 25 saves in his North Iowa debut. Each team claimed success on the power play, with North Iowa finishing 1-for-5 and the Bruins going 1-for-4.

#### **NEXT HOME GAME:**

The Bulls return to home ice Friday and Saturday, February 18 and 19 as the Bismarck Bobcats make the trip to Mason City. Friday's game is the Bulls' Fan Appreciation Night, with foam "Thumbs-Up" hands going to the first 100 fans in the door on National Thumbs-Up Night, and Saturday's game will feature an on-ice Tug-of-War tournament for National Tug-of-War Night.

#### SCOUT'S HONOR:

Bulls forward Michael Mesic made quite the impression among the scouts at the North American Hockey League's Top Prospects event in Pittsburgh this past Monday and Tuesday, as part of the NAHL Selects team - Mesic ripped a late goal for the Selects in Monday's 5-2 loss to the United States National Team Development Program's U17 squad, and added an assist the following day in a 3-2 win over the Midwest Division team. Bulls teammates Logan Dombrowsky, Byron Hartley and Dylan Gajewski appeared for the Central Division team in its 1-1 finish, but did not factor in the scoring in either a loss to the Midwest on Monday or a win over the South Division on Tuesday.

#### **PENNING QUITE THE STORY:**

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania native Byron Hartley continues to crank out the scoring for the Bulls, adding an assist in last Saturday's win over the Bruins he has posted points in six of his last eight games, bumping his total for the season to 14 goals and 11 assists. Of his 25 points this season, 12 have come just since January 15, and his 14 goals for the year tie for second on the team behind only Carter Rapalje.

### FINALLY HOME:

As junior hockey teams across the country lock in their final rosters for the season, the Bulls got quite a welcome gift from their newest netminder last weekend - Kyle Kozma made his North Iowa debut with 25 saves, earning the win in last Saturday's 4-2 win over Austin. Kozma is settling in at his final junior stop after previously winning five games for the Aberdeen Wings and Minnesota Magicians this year, and playing in his native Canada for the Virden Oil Capitals, North York Rangers and Drumheller Dragons in previous seasons. As if last week's game wasn't enough excitement, Kozma also celebrated his 21st birthday on Wednesday. Kozma was the goaltender in both of the Wings' first two regular-season games against North Iowa, splitting the two outings.

#### **HUNDO P = 100 POINTS:**

Jack Campion also earned a spot on the scoresheet last Saturday against the Bruins, putting him within two points of the century mark for his junior hockey career. Eight of those points have come since making his debut on the NAHL scoresheet on December 17 with an assist at Bismarck. Sota Isogai finally passed Campion for second place on the Mason City Toros' scoring list, despite Campion's absence from the Toros' roster since December 22.
