

IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa makes a welcome return to home ice with the last extended road stretch on the horizon.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

Tied. 3-3-0 (home team has won five of six in the head-to-head series).

LAST TIME OUT:

The Bulls tied last Saturday's game twice, but an insurance goal from Will Gilson with 8:49 remaining proved to be just enough cushion to help the Aberdeen Wings get past North Iowa in a 4-3 win, sealing a weekend sweep at the Odde Ice Center. Aberdeen and North Iowa put on a scoring rush midway through the first, starting with Kyle Gaffney's goal from Kevin MacKay at 10:25 - the Bulls tied it 48 seconds later when Hunter Bulger clipped Justin Mexico's shot coming down the zone, but the Wings got the lead back with 6:46 remaining on a goal from Devon Carlstrom. Byron Hartley rippled the net with 1:46 remaining to tie the game going to the intermission, with Aberdeen picking up 18 of the game's first 24 shots. The Wings got the lead for good at 4:40 of the second when Owen DuBois drove the puck down the left wing and dangled it past Hunter Garvey for the 3-2 lead. Gilson and Hartley traded goals just 16 seconds apart in the third, but North Iowa never got the tying goal back that it needed. Garvey made 34 saves in the loss, but Hartley notched two goals to highlight the North Iowa offense. The penalty-killing units were perfect again, combining to go 5-for-5.

NEXT HOME GAME:

The Bulls celebrate National "Drink Wine" Day and National Girl Scout Cookie Week for tonight's game, with discounted wine at the Bulls' beer stand and Girl Scout cookies available for purchase on the concourse. Season ticket holders also get any beer for just \$3 until puck drop as part of the team's Happy Hour promotion, and North Iowa players will be available for postgame "Friday Night Lights" autographs.

GETTING 'EM IN LINE:

North lowa's top line from last weekend continues to maintain its torrid scoring pace heading into the final 30 percent of the schedule - Jack Campion notched multi-point games in both outings against the Wings, while Michael Mesic has extended his team scoring lead to eight points over Logan Dombrowsky and Byron Hartley has picked up points in eight of his last 10 appearances. Four of those games have been multi-point outings.

DRIVE HOME SAFELY:

The Bulls are hoping to extend a trend that has remained fairly consistent in the first half-dozen meetings with Bismarck - in all but one of the meetings so far, the home team has come out on top. The lone exception came on January 22, when the Bobcats left the VFW Sports Center ice with a 4-3 loss to the Bulls. Dylan Gajewski factored into three of the four goals in that game, scoring the final go-ahead goal of the night. This game is the first home contest for North Iowa against Bismarck since November 6, with four more meetings on the slate after this weekend.

FOUR-POINT PLAY:

Jack Campion celebrated a milestone last weekend, becoming the 17th player in North Iowa Bulls history to hit the 100-point mark all-time on Friday and bumping his career mark to 102 on Saturday with two assists. The Crystal, Minnesota native earned his first NAHL point against the Bobcats just before Christmas, but seven of his 12 NAHL points thus far have come against the Wings.

HOCKEY 101:

North Iowa defenseman Greg Japchen celebrated a career milestone of his own last Saturday, playing in his 101st junior hockey game this evening (not including a single NCDC contest in 2018-19). Three of those games came in the United States Hockey League with Madison and Omaha, and the Bulls will likely mark a milestone in a more official manner next Friday at the Springfield Jr. Blues, barring any further absences from the lineup, as he takes the ice for his 100th North American Hockey League game.

BOBCATS LOOK BACK:

Bismarck split last weekend against Minot, taking a 4-2 loss on Friday behind a three-goal third period for the Minotauros. The Bobcats rebounded for a 5-1 win Saturday, thanks to a pair of goals from Brandon Reller and 26 saves from Oskar Spinnars Nordin.
