#### IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa begins its final extended road stretch of the season.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES:**

North lowa trails, 1-1-0 (Springfield leads 3-2 on points, due to overtime loss December 10).

#### LAST TIME OUT:

The Bulls head to the capital of Illinois looking to re-establish its link with the win column in the Land of Lincoln, following the first shutout involving North lowa this season last Saturday night. The Bismarck Bobcats picked up a 4-0 win, behind two goals from Drew Holt - the first of those goals came on a right-wing shot at 3:03 of the first period that put the visitors ahead, 1-0. Bismarck added a goal from Brady Egan at 12:12 of the period, following Egan's hat trick the previous night. An odd play from behind the net saw Holt direct the puck off the back of Hunter Garvey's pads and into the net from below the goal line, giving Bismarck a 3-0 lead at 4:02 of the second period, and the final goal from Quinn Rudrud beat Garvey high for a 4-0 Bobcat lead at 6:25 of the third. North lowa did wrap up the weekend perfect on the penalty kill, however, going 3-for-3 in Saturday's game and 5-for-5 for the week. Oskar Spinnars Nordin earned his fifth win against North Iowa in six tries, making 19 saves, while Bismarck cranked out 47 shots on goal in the game. Saturday's game was played in front of 1,504 fans, the Bulls' largest post-COVID crowd yet and the largest crowd to ever witness an NAHL game in Mason City.

#### **NEXT HOME GAME:**

The Bulls welcome the Austin Bruins to the River City on Friday, March 11 to begin the home stretch with "Reading Stampede" night, featuring a book exchange at the game.

#### **GETTING "2" A MILESTONE:**

North Iowa defenseman Greg Japchen is on track to celebrate a career milestone with his 100th North American Hockey League game, assuming a place in the lineup Friday night. Japchen joins Jack Mesic and Casey Roepke in reaching the 100-game mark in an NAHL uniform, while Jake LaRusso reached the century mark with the New Jersey Titans. The next North Iowa player on pace to play his 100th NAHL contest is Sean Vlasich, who comes into the weekend with 93 NAHL games under his belt.

#### A "LINC" TO THE PAST:

After hosting the Jr. Blues back in December, the Bulls make their first-ever trip to Springfield for Friday and Saturday's games - this week's visit to the capital city is the first by a Mason City-based team since November 15, 2008, when future Ohio State defenseman Alex Carlson scored the North Iowa Outlaws' only goal in a 4-1 loss. The Outlaws went 6-8-1 at the Nelson Center, including an overtime loss to close out the team's final postseason run in 2009.

#### **LET'S GET TOGETHER:**

North Iowa's most recent game last Saturday night made Mason City hockey history once again, with more than 1,500 fans packing into the Mason City Arena to watch the Bulls face off against the Bobcats. Last Saturday's attendance is the largest yet for the Bulls since COVID restrictions curtailed attendance last year in Mason City to a maximum of 1,100 fans, and it was also the largest crowd ever to witness a North American Hockey League game in Mason City. Last Saturday's crowd would have busted the "Barn," which saw its biggest NAHL crowd of 1,457 fans on March 24, 2007 for a 4-3 win over the Alaska Avalanche - the teams combined to go an incredible 7-for-23 on the power play in that game.

#### **HEAVY HITTERS:**

The two teams combined to score 16 goals in their weekend get-together two weeks before Christmas, and two players in particular handled a hefty chunk of the scoring in those two games. Dylan Gajewski notched a hat trick in the Friday night affair, a 4-3 overtime win that included an overtime winner for Gajewski in just his third game with the team. Hagen Moe would score two goals in that game before scoring another one in a 6-3 win the following night - that night was a particularly potent one for the Bulls' power play, with a pair of goals in the contest. Moe also scored the Jr. Blues' only goal of the weekend last week, with Springfield taking 3-0 and 9-1 losses at the Janesville Jets.
