IN A NUTSHELL:

North Iowa looks to shake off a Friday night defeat and end its last weekend in North Dakota on a high note.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

North Iowa trails, 3-6-0 (Bismarck: three straight wins head-to-head).

LAST TIME OUT:

The Bulls got off to a stellar start on Friday night, but the Bismarck Bobcats battled back from a two-goal deficit to score the final six goals of the night on the way to their sixth straight win, a 6-2 victory at the V.F.W. Sports Center. North Iowa took command with two goals barely a minute-and-a-half apart in the first period, on a one-timer from **Brett Morich** at the 10:39 mark and a left-wing wrist shot from **Jack Mesic** at 12:20 of the first. Bismarck began climbing out of the hole with 6:03 remaining, on a power play following a holding call against **Sean Vlasich** – Ryan Taylor's one-timer from the left wing put the Bobcats back within one going to the second period. Drew Holt tied the game at 8:11 of the second period, and a one-timer from Jake McLean on the right wing with 6:02 remaining in the period put Bismarck ahead for good. Just two seconds out of a power play, the Bobcats added a momentum boost on a tip from Patrick Johnson in front of the net, deflecting home Michael Neumeier's shot for a 4-2 intermission lead. A breakaway goal from Brandon Reller at 5:39 of the third and a second marker from Taylor with 7:32 remaining capped the scoring. Oskar Spinnars Nordin picked up his sixth win of the year against North Iowa and 12th overall, making 18 saves, while **Hunter Garvey** took the loss behind a 29-save performance.

NEXT HOME GAME:

The Bulls welcome the Austin Bruins to the River City on Friday, March 11 to begin the home stretch with "Reading Stampede" night, including a book exchange at the game and a raffle for a Dr. Seuss collection. Bring in books to donate to the exchange ahead of game day and receive \$1 off your admission per book (up to a \$5 maximum discount).

SATURDAY NIGHT RESURGENCE:

Last night's loss to the Bobcats marked Bismarck's fourth straight Friday night win in the head-to-head series, with the Bulls picking up the win November 5 in the first-ever meeting between the teams. Since that initial weekend, Bismarck has taken six of seven from North Iowa, but it was a happy bus ride home for the Bulls in their last trip to the Flickertail State, winning a 4-3 contest on January 22. **Dylan Gajewski** had a goal and two assists in that game, putting North Iowa in front for the last of their three leads that night. It was the first win for the road team in the series after five straight home victories.

YOU'RE A DUTCHMAN, JOEY:

North Iowa has its next college commitment, with defenseman **Joey Potter** announcing his commitment to NCAA Division I Union College this week. Potter is one of five players on the North Iowa roster with an NCAA Division I commitment, and fourth Bull to make a Division I announcement this season, following **Michael Mesic** (Northern Michigan), Jack Mesic (Ferris State) and Sean Vlasich (Army). He has two more seasons of junior eligibility after this year, and will eventually join fellow Bulls blueliner **Greg Japchen** on the Dutchmen roster.

FOREVER YOUNG:

The future is bright for both groups in this weekend's matchup, as the Bulls and Bismarck ice two of the three youngest teams in the North American Hockey League – only the Chippewa Steel, with three 2004-born players and a dozen 2003-born players on hand this season, have rostered a younger group. Michael Mesic continues his strong run, with points in five of his last seven games – with 42 points, he not only leads the Bulls in scoring, but is the highest-scoring 17-year-old in the NAHL, ahead of Corpus Christi's Stepan Kuznetsov and his 27 points.

A HOT TEAM IN THE OLD TOWN TONIGHT:

Bismarck remains the Central Division's hottest team, winning six straight heading into tonight's game. Brady Egan has led the charge for them, with seven goals in those six games. In five games against North Iowa, Egan has notched six goals and three assists, including a hat trick in the Bobcats' 6-2 win at the Mason City Arena on February 18. Quinn Rudrud has also come up large for the 'Cats, with points in five straight games and 12 of 15, totaling 10 goals and eight assists in that time. Only Janesville (eight straight wins) and Lone Star (10-game point streak) are currently riding hotter streaks than the Bobcats.
