IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa winds down another season series as crunch time continues in the Central Division.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

North Iowa trails, 2-4-4 (four of Bulls' six overtime/shootout losses have come against Aberdeen).

LAST TIME OUT:

One night after the Austin Bruins shook off an early 2-0 deficit and surged to a 5-2 win in Mason City, the Bruins held off North Iowa in a defensive struggle Saturday night to pick up a 2-1 victory at the Riverside Arena and close out the head-to-head season series with a victory. The Bruins dialed up a goal at 6:55 of the opening period, when Alex Trombley dragged the puck around **Hunter Garvey** and dished it into the top half of the net for a 1-0 lead. The teams picked up the pace significantly in the second period, with the Bulls taking a 17-13 shots-on-goal advantage in the middle stanza, but as a power play began, Walter Zacher led an odd-man rush into the Bulls' zone and ripped a goal with 3:07 left in the period for a 2-0 lead. North Iowa scored on a 4-on-4 chance with 49 seconds left in the period, as **Greg Japchen** bounded the puck off of Ethan Robertson and into the net. The teams never scored again, despite North Iowa ending the game on a two-minute power play and spending the last 54 seconds of the game on a 6-on-4 with the empty net. Garvey made 34 saves in taking the loss, while Robertson earned his third win of the year against the Bulls with 38 stops. Zacher posted the only multi-point performance, with a goal and an assist in both games of the weekend.

TONIGHT'S PROMOTIONS:

The Bulls welcome the Aberdeen Wings on the team's Hometown Heroes night, presented by T-Mobile of Mason City – all veterans and active military members receive free admission to the game.

ONE OUTTA TWO AIN'T BAD:

Though the Wings have won eight out of 10 against North Iowa this season, the Bulls have been in just about every meeting with Aberdeen this season. Of their six overtime and shootout losses this year, four have come against Aberdeen, including three shootout losses – it's the first time in a decade that North Iowa has played the same team to a shootout three times in one year. The Wings have gotten quite comfortable in the extra session this season, with 11 games going beyond the regulation 60 minutes. Only Odessa, the Minnesota Magicians, Maryland and Jamestown, with a dozen apiece, and Lone Star – with a whopping 17 games – have played more bonus hockey than the Wings have.

"C" FOR CAPTAIN, "C" FOR CENTURY MARK:

Tonight, North Iowa captain Sean Vlasich is set to become the latest Bulls player to reach the century mark with his 100th career North American Hockey League contest – he is the fifth North Iowa player this season to reach the century mark, after Greg Japchen made his 100th appearance at Springfield in late February and Jack Mesic and Casey Roepke got to 100 before the new calendar year. Sota Isogai reached the 100 mark in his first NAHL game prior to Thanksgiving, while Jake LaRusso played in his 100th NAHL game while still with the New Jersey Titans.

HOMESTYLE HOCKEY:

The home stretch truly picks up steam tonight, as the Bulls hit the home ice for eight of their last 10 games. Both remaining road games will be played as part of home-and-home weekends against St. Cloud, after the Bulls went 8-10 on their nine overnight road trips this season. Last year was a reversal of the typical schedule, with the Bulls finishing their regular season on the road for seven of their final 10 contests.

FLYING HIGH AGAINST THE WINGS:

No Bulls player has scored more against Aberdeen this season than **Michael Mesic**, especially in recent meetings – the future Northern Michigan Wildcat has posted nine points over his last five games against the Wings, including a three-goal, two-assist weekend in South Dakota January 28 and 29.

CAMPING OUT IN THE SCORING COLUMN:

Forward Jack Campion comes into the weekend with 14 points since joining the NAHL roster on December 10, but half of those have come in just six appearances against the Wings. Among those seven points against Aberdeen was his 100th junior point, which came in an overtime loss on February 11.
