IN A NUTSHELL:

North lowa looks to build on the success of Friday's win and continue its climb back into Central Division playoff contention

ALL-TIME SERIES:

North Iowa leads, 5-2-0 (Bulls: clinched head-to-head season series last night).

LAST TIME OUT:

A second-period hiccup hardly slowed the Bulls down Friday night, posting two goals in the game's opening 6:12 and earning a much-needed 5-3 win over Minot to jump back within five points of the Central Division's final Robertson Cup playoff spot. A goal from **Greg Japchen** just inside the blue line put North lowa up just 4:14 into the contest, and **Hunter Bulger** banged in a shot in front of the net less than two minutes later. The race was on after that – Minot shrank the lead to 2-1 at 2:41 of the second on a goal from Colby Joseph, but the Bulls answered back with a 3-on-2 tally from **Byron Hartley** on the left wing. Braydon Beahm buried a chance on the power play with 4:09 left in the period, but the Bulls responded 19 seconds later on a breakaway goal from **Carter Rapalje**. The lead dipped back to 3-2 just 30 seconds after that, when David Nesburg squared up and snapped one down the slot to beat **Hunter Garvey** and send Minot to the third period down just a goal. Of the 17 shots on net in the third, only Hartley's toss from neutral ice into an empty net with 1:13 remaining added to the score. Hartley had a career night, with two goals and an assist, tying his season-best performance. **Jack Phelan** and Garvey both notched their first assists of the year with secondary helpers, and Garvey made 27 saves to earn his 15th win of the year.

TONIGHT'S PROMOTIONS:

The Bulls welcome their billet and player families to this weekend's games, and the Bulls' specialty jerseys this evening's will be auctioned off following the contest, with a postgame skate – proceeds from tonight's postgame jersey auction will benefit Mason City Parks and Recreation.

SPEAK NOW, OR...:

If North lowa is going to make its playoff push, this may be the weekend to do it – the Bulls currently sit five points back of the fourth and final Central Division playoff spot with seven games to go. The final team slotted into the playoffs *is* the Minot team that North lowa faces this weekend – with a sweep, the Bulls could find themselves as close as three points out of fourth place with six games left, putting them right in the hunt with three weeks remaining. A loss tonight could put the Bulls right back at a seven-point gap.

HIGH-FLYING HARTLEY:

Forward **Byron Hartley** has been a terror for the Minotauros this season, with his two goals in Friday's game bumping his total to seven goals in as many games against Minot this season. On four separate occasions, he's posted three points in a night – two of those came against the Minotauros, including on January 15 in a 5-4 North lowa victory at the Maysa Arena where Hartley picked up the game-winning goal. His two goals last night bumped him up to 20 for the season, the second Bull to reach that mark.

HOMING IN ON THE POSTSEASON:

A busy home stretch continues, with the Bulls on home ice for eight of their last 10 games. Both remaining road games are scheduled as part of homeand-home weekends against first-place St. Cloud, against whom four of the Bulls' final six games will be played.

FIRST THINGS FIRST:

North lowa enjoyed a pair of firsts in last night's game, with Hunter Garvey notching his first assist of the year and Jack Phelan posting his first career junior assist. Garvey picked up one assist last season with the Amarillo Bulls, while Phelan helped set up Rapalje's rush for the eventual game-winner in the second period. Phelan was playing in just his fifth junior contest out of the Chicago Mission 18-and-under program.

TOUGH-TO-TAME TAUROS:

Not many teams have been tougher to hold down than Minot going into the final 20 minutes – the Minotauros have come back from a second-intermission deficit for six wins this year. Only New Mexico (seven wins) has a better mark, and Jamestown is the only other NAHL team to match it. Colby Joseph leads the way against North Iowa, with nine points against the Bulls this year.
