## IN A NUTSHELL:

The final stretch of the regular season begins, with the first-place Norsemen on the schedule for four of the final six games.

### **ALL-TIME SERIES:**

North Iowa trails, 1-2-1 (St. Cloud: three consecutive wins head-to-head).

#### LAST TIME OUT:

North lowa opened its Saturday night clash with the Minot Minotauros with another perfect period, but the Minotauros chipped away before scoring two game-tying goals in the third period and eventually sealing a 4-3 shootout victory. The Bulls snagged two goals just 79 seconds apart late in the opening period, taking a 2-0 lead to the locker room with a give-and-go tally from **Hunter Bulger** with 6:05 left and a top-corner rope from **Dylan Gajewski** with 4:46 remaining. Huston Karpman weaved through the traffic and snapped one past **Kyle Kozma** on the stick side with 4:21 left in the second period to cut the lead, and Connor McGrath dragged the puck across the front of the net before stuffing it in with 5:32 remaining. **Carter Rapalje** banged in a rebound on the power play with 3:08 left to retake the lead, but Colby Joseph found a loose puck in front of the net with an extra attacker on the ice to tie the game again with 46 seconds on the third-period clock. Karpman notched the only goal of the shootout, sending Minot home with the win and adding onto his goal and assist. Kozma made 31 stops to take the shootout loss, while McGrath posted a goal and two assists for the 'Tauros.

### TONIGHT'S PROMOTIONS:

The Bulls are observing a "Why Not Wednesday" for this game, with \$5 adult tickets and free kids' admission. Domestic beers for this rare midweek home contest are just \$2.

### HARDWARE FOR HARTLEY:

North lowa forward **Byron Hartley** is back on a hot streak, his second scoring run of the season, and it's netted him some hardware going into the week. Hartley posted two goals and two assists in the Bulls' three-point weekend, earning his first Central Division Star of the Week award – the Philly native has seven points over his last six games, scoring points in five of the six. Earlier this yeae, he posted 15 points in a 10-game span, with points in eight of those 10 outings.

### **RAPALJE ON A ROLL:**

Bulls forward Carter Rapalje is on a hot streak after posting a goal in Saturday's game, bumping his mark to four straight games with at least one goal. It's the fourth time this season that a North Iowa player has gone four straight games with a goal – Byron Hartley posted a four-game goal-scoring streak in early October, while Dylan Gajewski opened his time with the Bulls in December with seven goals in his four-game run. Michael Mesic scored a goal in four straight around the Christmas break. No North Iowa player has scored a goal in five straight games since last season's five-game early-February run by current Springfield Jr. Blue **Carson Jones**.

#### **LEAVING HOME:**

North lowa's longest sustained homestand of the year ends with tonight's game – the Bulls will play their fifth straight home game tonight as part of a run of eight home contests in the final 10 games of the regular season. All three remaining home games will be played in a block as well, from April 8 to 15.

#### ONE POINT AT A TIME:

Last Saturday's shootout loss to Minot expanded the gap to six points between the fourth-place Minotauros and North Iowa. The Bulls have two games in hand on Minot, plus the head-to-head tiebreaker, meaning the Minotauros could eliminate North Iowa by winning out, or losing one of their four remaining games in overtime or a shootout.

#### O' MY GOODNESS:

St. Cloud is the first Central Division team to clinch a playoff spot, eight points clear of the field with two games in hand on second-place Aberdeen. Ryan O'Neill is intent on finishing his junior career on a tear, after recently suiting up for his 150<sup>th</sup> NAHL game – O'Neill has points in nine straight games, with five goals and 14 assists in that span. He set two new career highs March 18 against Austin, with four assists among a five-point outing.
