IN A NUTSHELL:

The Bulls continue their quest to make up the final few points against Minot and catch the fourth-place Minotauros.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

North Iowa trails, 1-2-2 (St. Cloud: four consecutive wins head-to-head).

LAST TIME OUT:

North Iowa battled to a stalemate in the first period and briefly fell behind by three goals on Wednesday night, roaring back with a huge finish to the second period before ultimately falling in overtime, 4-3 to the St. Cloud Norsemen. The first period went by uneventfully, with no goals on 20 combined shots and no penalties for either side. Blake Mesenburg opened the scoring with a bottle-popper at 4:20 of the second period, and the Bulls nearly killed off St. Cloud's first power play of the night before coming up just 29 seconds short as Nik Hong split the defense in transition to score with a shot down the slot. A runaway wraparound chance from Blake Perbix ended up out front for Mesenburg to bang in for the 3-0 advantage with 2:57 remaining in the period. The Bulls fired off an impressive comeback with a runaway goal from **Carter Rapalje** just 16 seconds later, and **Jack Champion** rifled a shot to the top corner to cut the lead to 3-2 with 38 seconds left in the period. **Jack Mesic** completed the comeback with a snipe from the slot at 5:41 of the third period, and the teams battled to overtime. North Iowa got a handful of solid chances in the extra session, including a penalty shot for Rapalje, but a one-timer from Ryan O'Neill found Mesenburg in the right-wing circle for his third goal of the night with just 37 seconds left. **Hunter Garvey** took the loss despite making 32 saves on 36 St. Cloud shots, while Norsemen goalie Tomas Bolo stopped 27 shots for his fifth win of the year against the Bulls.

NEXT HOME GAME:

The Bulls return home next weekend for a Friday-Saturday set against the Bismarck Bobcats – Friday's game is North Iowa's "Room and Boarding" night, with \$5 admission for college students with a valid student ID and \$3 domestic beers. Saturday night, the Bulls welcome local Scouts and 4-H clubs for their "Junior Community Partner Night."

HARDWARE FOR HARTLEY:

North Iowa forward **Byron Hartley** is back on a hot streak, and it's netted him some hardware going into the week. Hartley posted two goals and two assists in the Bulls' three-point week against Minot, earning his first Central Division Star of the Week award – the Philly native has eight points over his last seven games, scoring points in six of the seven. Earlier this year, he posted 15 points in a 10-game span, with points in eight of those 10 outings.

RUNAWAY RAPALJE:

Bulls forward Carter Rapalje continued his torrid run with another goal on Wednesday, extending his mark to five straight games with at least one goal. It's the first time this season, and the first in North Iowa's NAHL era, that a North Iowa player has gone five straight games with a goal – no North Iowa player has scored a goal in five straight games since last season's early-February run by current Springfield Jr. Blue Carson Jones. A goal tonight would give him the team's first six-game goal-scoring run since Jarod Blackowiak's six-goal streak in November of 2018. The longest regular-season run belongs to Tim Santopalo, with goals in eight straight during the 2013-14 campaign – the longest overall run is Joe Burgmeier's, ending the 2015-16 regular season with goals in seven straight games before scoring in all four NA3HL Central Division playoff games as well.

ONE POINT AT A TIME:

Wednesday's game narrowed the gap between the fourth-place Minotauros and North Iowa to five points, with five games remaining and Minot idle this weekend. The Bulls have one game in hand on Minot, plus the head-to-head tiebreaker, meaning that should North Iowa win out, the Minotauros would need to win three of their final four games, or win two and take the other two to overtime, to eliminate the Bulls from the playoff race.

NORSEMEN NOTES:

St. Cloud is the first Central Division team to clinch a playoff spot, 10 points clear of the field with one game in hand on second-place Aberdeen. Ryan O'Neill O'Neill has points in 10 straight games, tied for the longest scoring stretch since the team's 2019 move from Brookings, South Dakota. He set two new career highs in an 8-2 win over Austin on March 18, with four assists among a five-point outing. Nick Young is set to make his 100th NAHL appearance tonight as well, while Broten Sabo and Blake Perbix played in their 100th NAHL games last week.
